

Jardine Muffler Repack Guide

Why: After a year and a half I decided it needed some new fibreglass. The sound was still loud, but it started making a rattle sound and I lost that deep growl it had. So I ordered some fibreglass.

What you need:

Rivet Gun and Rivets
Rubber Mallet
RTV High Temp Sealant
Drill and Drills
New Universal Motorcycle Fibreglass Pack
Gloves and Mask

Skill level: Easy/medium

As you can see in the picture the fibreglass was thin and brittle and charred up. Basically it's worn out.



I put in some beefier rivets and resealed all the seams with the silicone. I kind of got carried away and made a mess but there's no leak in my muffler or the headers!

Result: A nice muffled deep sound especially in deceleration. No more rattle. I lost a couple decibels but it's still loud. I'm very happy with it. Anybody should do this to any aftermarket slip-on if they want. Very easy and saves you hundreds of dollars.
