

## Rentec Luggage Rack Review

It took six weeks to arrive.

It is easy to mount on the bike, although the bars of the rack that bolt to the bike are a bit wide and need to be pushed together a little to make it work. The bars provide places to hook bungee cords too! With this luggage rack on, I can still get the straps to my Nelson Rigg saddlebags under the seat.

I was worried the rack might be on the large side and sort of overwhelm the bike, but that is not a problem. I think the rack looks good on the bike, as far as luggage racks go. I've included some pictures with stuff on the rack to provide some perspective. Attached Images:

I don't know how the other racks mount. For this, you just remove the bolts that are on the bike that hold the grab handles on (I didn't have the handles, but the bolts are there). Put the rack in place, put the bolts in. I bolted the right hand side (if you were sitting on the bike) down, and then pushed on the left side so the holes in the luggage rack bar aligned with the holes in the bike, put the remaining two bolts in.

When you take the rack out of the packaging and just eyeball it to see how it will align with the holes on the bike, it looks like it is a little too wide. However, I got it installed without much trouble. I called the seller and informed him of this.
